4. Examine 'Kubla Khan' as a poem dealing with the process of artistic creativity.
5. How does Keats combine the natural, the animal and the human worlds in his poems? Elucidate using examples from his poems included in your syllabus.
6. Elaborate on the mythopoeic element in the poetry of Shelley with special reference to 'Ode to the West Wind'.

7. The Monster, not Victor, is the real hero of *Frankenstein*. Do you agree? Give reasons for your answer.
8. Comment on the Gothic elements found in *Frankenstein*.
